

The service line is the pipe coming from outside into your water meter. You can tell what your service line is made of by using a magnet (*a refrigerator magnet will do*) and a coin.

Does a magnet stick to your service line? Yes No

Scratch your service line with a coin. What color is the area you scratched (see figure)?



Does the service line curve or does it have a bulb on the end? Yes No
(if YES, it is likely lead)

Type of service line: *(Please Circle)* Lead Copper Galvanized Plastic

Galvanized: Magnet will stick & and has the color of dull gray .
Lead: Magnet will <u>not</u> stick & and when scratched with the coin has the color of shiny silver .
Copper: Magnet will <u>not</u> stick & has the color of a tarnished penny .
Plastic: Magnet will <u>not</u> stick & usually has colors of white or gray .
