

**REPORT TO MAYOR DUGGAN

REGARDING THE PROPOSED
PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT PROJECT
AT 1501-1567 CHURCH, 1606-1622 CHURCH, 1611 MICHIGAN
ADJACENT TO AND WITHIN THE CORKTOWN HISTORIC DISTRICT
MARCH 10, 2021**

Pursuant to Section 21-2-5 of the 2019 Detroit City Code, “Effects of projects on districts,” the Detroit Historic District Commission, at their regular meeting on Wednesday, March 10, 2021, completed an advisory review for a proposed project referred to it by the Detroit Economic Growth Corporation. The project includes the demolition of an existing building within the historic district, new buildings adjacent to and within the district, and a parking structure within the district.

The Detroit Historic District Commission has determined that “the proposed project will have a demonstrable effect on the Corktown Historic District, and that demonstrable effect is likely to be beneficial, subject to the condition that the historic Self-Storage building be retained.”
