At the Regular Meeting that was held on February 7, 2024, the Detroit Historic District Commission ("DHDC") reviewed the above-referenced application. Pursuant to Section 5(1) of the Michigan Local Historic District Act, as amended, being MCL 399.205 (1) and Sections 21-2-73/21-2-78 of the 2019 Detroit City Code; the DHDC hereby issues a Certificate of Appropriateness ("COA") for the following work, effective on February 13, 2024, as it meets the Secretary of Interior's Standards for Rehabilitation and the district's Elements of Design:

Add roof dormers, rehabilitate dwelling per the submitted drawings, narrative, and documents

With the following design conditions subject to staff approval:

- Instead of the proposed sliding doors at the rear, the two large 2/1 (two over one) paired windows at the rear be replaced with a pair of 2/1 (two over one) French doors
- The front porch and rear deck rail designs should be further developed, and distinct from each other, as they have different roles to play in the historic understanding of this house. The front porch rail should be historically correct, while the rear deck balustrade should be of a more contemporary character distinguishing the deck as a later addition.
