- -At the east wall: remove existing wood siding for use where wood is missing at west wall; Install 5/16" James Hardi, "HardiPlank" fiber cement siding. Board height of 5.5" providing 4" exposure reveal.
- -At north wall: restore wood siding that is under the asphalt "Insulbirck" siding at the 3rd story, gable end
