 - As a resident of Detroit's Lafayette Park Historic District, I oppose the project.
 - The project is **NOT** historically appropriate.
 - Detroit Thermal's application is inaccurate and incomplete. It contains at least 21 errors where 50-foot mature trees are missing, mislabeled as shrubs, or under-identified in size. The landscape took 60 years of investment from you and our neighborhood to become what it is today. It cannot be replaced.
 - The project will have a significant adverse effect on the landscape. It will negatively impact at least 22 mature trees. Detroit Thermal has never asked you for your input on its plans.
