Please help us maintain our mature trees from the damage that will be caused by allowing multiple heavy machinery onto our property. Lafayette Park is a National Landmark not just for the architecture but also the over 60 year old upper story Honey Locust trees. Please help us protect them from damage by Detroit Thermal.
