

• 2019 Kevin and Gretchen moved into house



- -please provide individual photos of the existing wing proposed for removal, at both the interior and exterior. The commission will need to zoom in on the photos to understand the age, etc of the wing.
- -please provide cutsheets/manufacturer's for all exterior doors, stucco, exterior light fixtures, roof shingles (outlining color) and brick for the new rear addition -If you are stating that want to remove the wing because it is structurally unsound, the commission will also require that that you submit a condition assessment which was conducted by a licensed structural engineer. As I have noted to Kevin, the due date for your complete application to be docketed on the July 8 HDC meeting is June 22nd.
