For: 1402 Vinewood, Detroit, MI 48216

Request: Remove a vertical slider window and replace with vinyl siding to match the rest of the house.

Date: July 1, 2022

- 1. Please provide a detailed image of the existing siding to show what is existing, and an image of the siding you are replacing it with. What is the material of the replacement siding?**

Answer: The replacement material is vinyl. It is the same color and size of the rest of the house. The replacement vinyl siding will be purchased from Eastern Michigan Distributors. It is the SC Clapboard – D4 Pebble Clay. It match the existing vinyl siding.



This is the South facing window to be removed. The opening will be closed with the same vinyl siding that is current on the house.

- 2. We need to know what the existing material is of siding. Wood- aluminum – vinyl?**

Answer: The existing material is vinyl.

- 3. Also note the size of existing exposure and size of replacement exposure. This means the size of the area between horizontal boards.**

Answer: The opening size of the vertical window to be removed is 48 inch in height by 36 in in width.

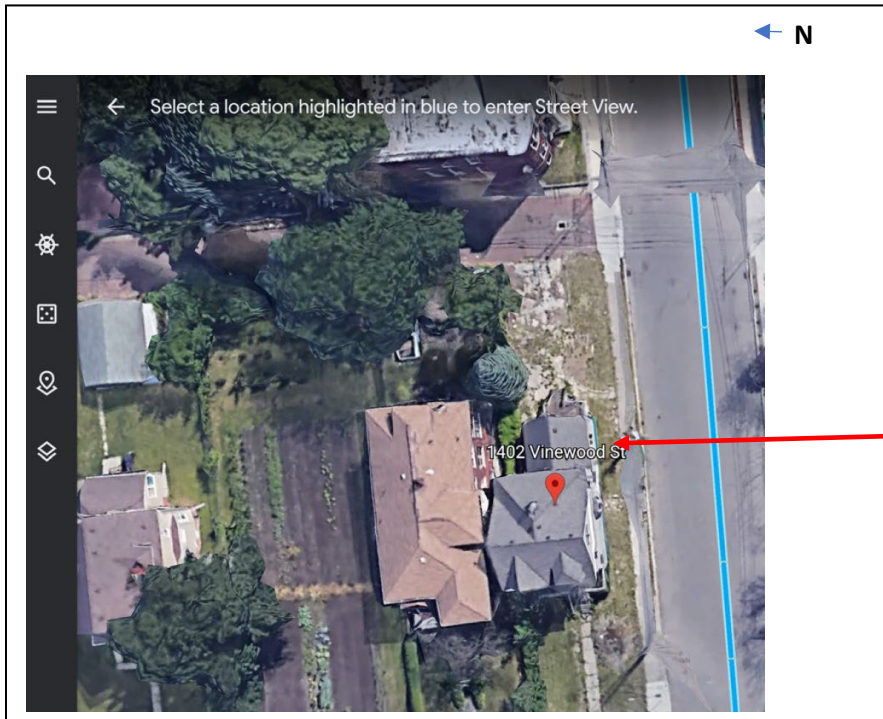
