# 1424 Iroquois St Porch Cap Replacement

#### Proposal


- Expected Timing: October 2022
- Demo and remove damaged porch cap inclusive of the decorative tile (not original) and concrete cap (original) and pour a new 4" thick concrete porch cap in accordance with the original design
- Multiple masonry experts have confirmed that the concrete cap is structurally compromised and cannot be repaired
- We have reviewed the architectural drawings (photo attached herein) and visited/spoken with Albert Kahn Associates to confirm that a concrete cap is the original design
- Madison Maintenance LLC will perform the work. This contractor has extensive experience working in Indian Village and other Detroit historic districts

#### Detailed Scope of Work

- Demo and remove the existing damaged porch cap
- Prep area
- Measure and install form boards
- Install re-rod along wall of home
- Pour new 4" thick concrete porch cap, 6 bag mix 4,000 PSI
- Conduct any necessary grinding and tuck pointing on front porch walls using type S mortar mix
- Remove all job-related debris
- Remove form boards and acid wash once cured
- Perform final clean up


## Existing Condition (1 of 4)

Concrete cap is fully compromised – holes all the way through the concrete cap and there is caving in around the holes










# Architectural Drawing – Original Design
