Scope of Work – Porches

- New decking (5/4 tongue & groove decking Douglas Fir) completed
- Replace railings and spindles with cedar
- Support posts that are too wide (one from each porch) completed
- Replace porch stringers, stair treads and risers completed
- Resupport posts footings where necessary
- Add hand rails to the stairs
- New Douglas Fir tongue and groove porch ceiling completed
- Replace porch fascia where needed

Scope of Work – Lap siding, trim, soffit, and fascia

Material: fiber cement siding and wood

- Replace wood lap siding on the front and sides of structure with Hardie Plank smooth lap siding. Will match in previous dimension and profile.
- Replace trim, soffit and fascia

Scope of Work – Exterior paint

- Body B4: Moderate Yellow
- Trim C4: Yellowish White
- Porch C4: Yellowish White

Scope of Work – Windows/Doors

- Replace front doors. Current front doors mismatch. One wood flush door and one ¾ lite. Replace with ¾ lite matching doors. Picture attached.
- Replace windows. Current windows deteriorated, warped and painted with Lead paint. Replace with Andersen 100 series windows. Color Black
