I sincerely hope that HDC requires the removal of the downlighting. Besides the downlighting not being historically accurate and not being aesthetically pleasing, they shine light directly into my windows and flood my property with light both in the front and back yards. I believe city ordinance prohibits the lighting of neighboring properties.

I have tried discussing the issue with my neighbor on several occasions and nothing has been resolved.

Background: I have been in my house since 2014. The owner of 2027 at that time had old fixtures on the eaves but had **never** turned them on. When the new owner purchased the home they started turning them on and replaced them with new super bright and sterile LED fixtures in June 2021. I've had a number of complaints from other neighbors about it so we decided to report the issue finally.
