<u>Columns</u>

There were a couple reasons why we altered the two half columns:

- 1) The columns were cut to match lap siding. With having to rebuild this entire porch they didn't line back up correctly with the siding and made it look bad
- 2) The bases of the half columns were starting to rot.
- 3) The columns are the same width that were in the prints we give to the commission. The image was just an example.
- 4) Overall, it looks better to have matching material than piecing together this porch.

Skirting

Decided to go with diamonds on the outside of the skirting rather than permanently cutting in the skirting.

Spindles

When we started with the 6" gap in-between the spindles, it didn't look correct to what a Victorian porch should look like so we with a smaller gap in between the spindles.

<u>Paint</u>

We have our approval from HDC for paint. We are currently prepping the siding for paint DHDC 23-8270
