




KEYED NOTES:

1	NEW STAINED GLASS WINDOW IN EXISTING MASONRY OPENING. FINAL THEME OF WINDOW AND DESIGNED BY STAINED GLASS ARTIST
2	INFILL FORMER PLYWOOD OPENING WITH MASONRY
3	REPAIR DAMAGED SHINGLES THIS AREA
4	REMOVE EXISTING PAINT AT ENTRANCE ON DOORS, SIDESLITES AND OVERHEAD CANOPY STRUCTURE DOWN TO BARE WOOD, PRIME AND REPAINT
5	REMOVE ANY RUST AND LOOSE PAINT OFF EXISTING EXTERIOR STAIR, PRIME AND REPAINT

6 RECONDITION EXISTING WINDOWS. REMOVE STORM ENCLOSURE, STRIP PAINT OFF, REPAIR ANY DAMAGED WOOD AREAS, PRIME AND REPAINT

GENERAL NOTES:

1. TUCKPOINT EXISTING MASONRY FACADE. USE A SAND BASED MORTAR, COLORED TO MATCH EXISTING JOINTS

2. REPAIR ANY CRACKS IN THE MASONRY, REMOVE EXISTING BRICK IN AREA OF CRACK, SALVAGE AND REBUILD AS REQUIRED.

3. INSPECT ALL EXISTING LINTELS AT MASONRY OPENINGS. ANY DAMAGED LINTELS ARE TO BE REMOVED AND REPLACED W/ A NEW LINTEL.
