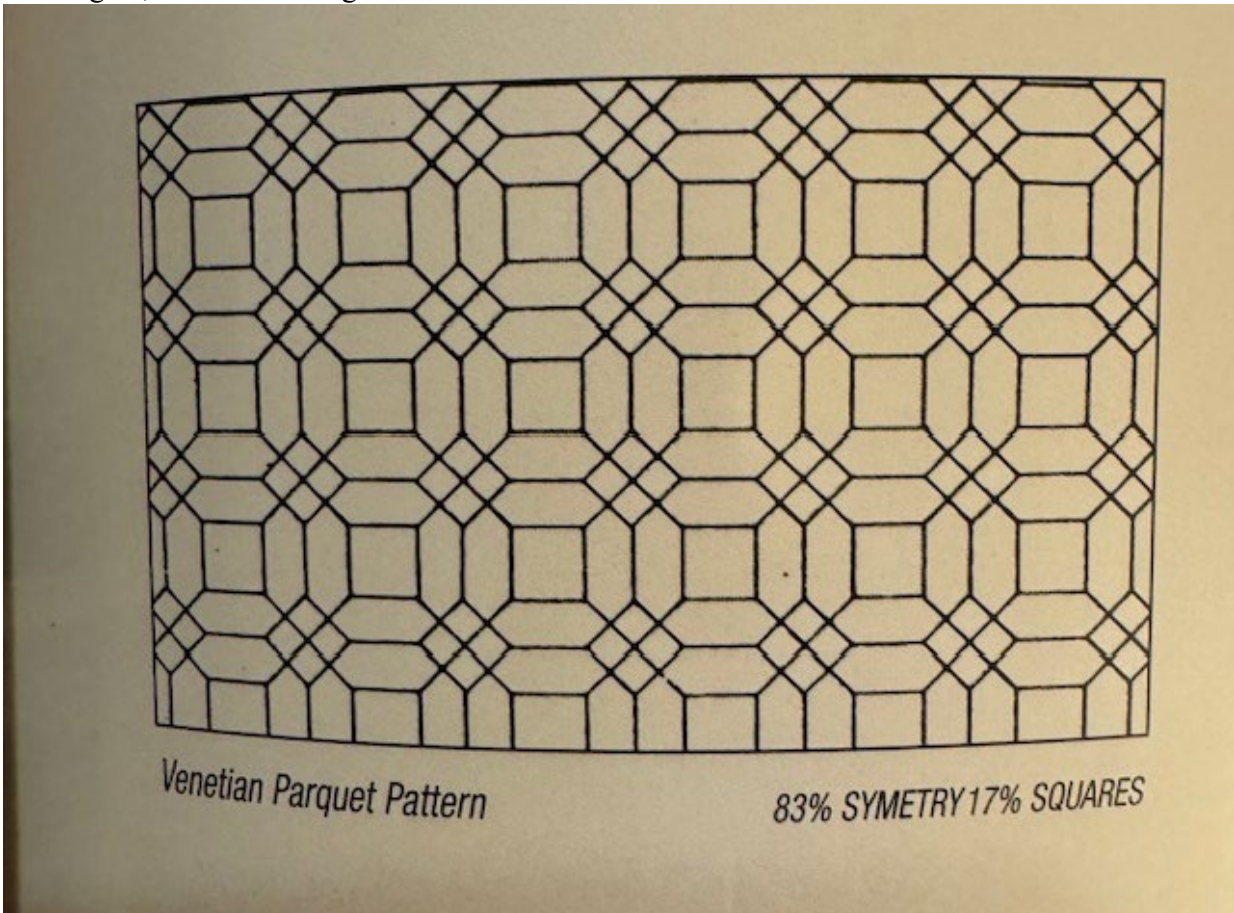
Good afternoon, Ms. Dye.

I have additional information.

Lopez Landscaping (referred by Fendt) came by and left the attached proposal. They propose to:

- match the current design as I previously indicated with octagons that are 24" in size (as opposed to the current 12" octagons);
- remove the current stone tiles and brick border (to ensure the proper pitch), leaving the steps and brick wall intact;
- break up the concrete;
- install new ground stone;
- match the rustic colors

Once again, here is the design:





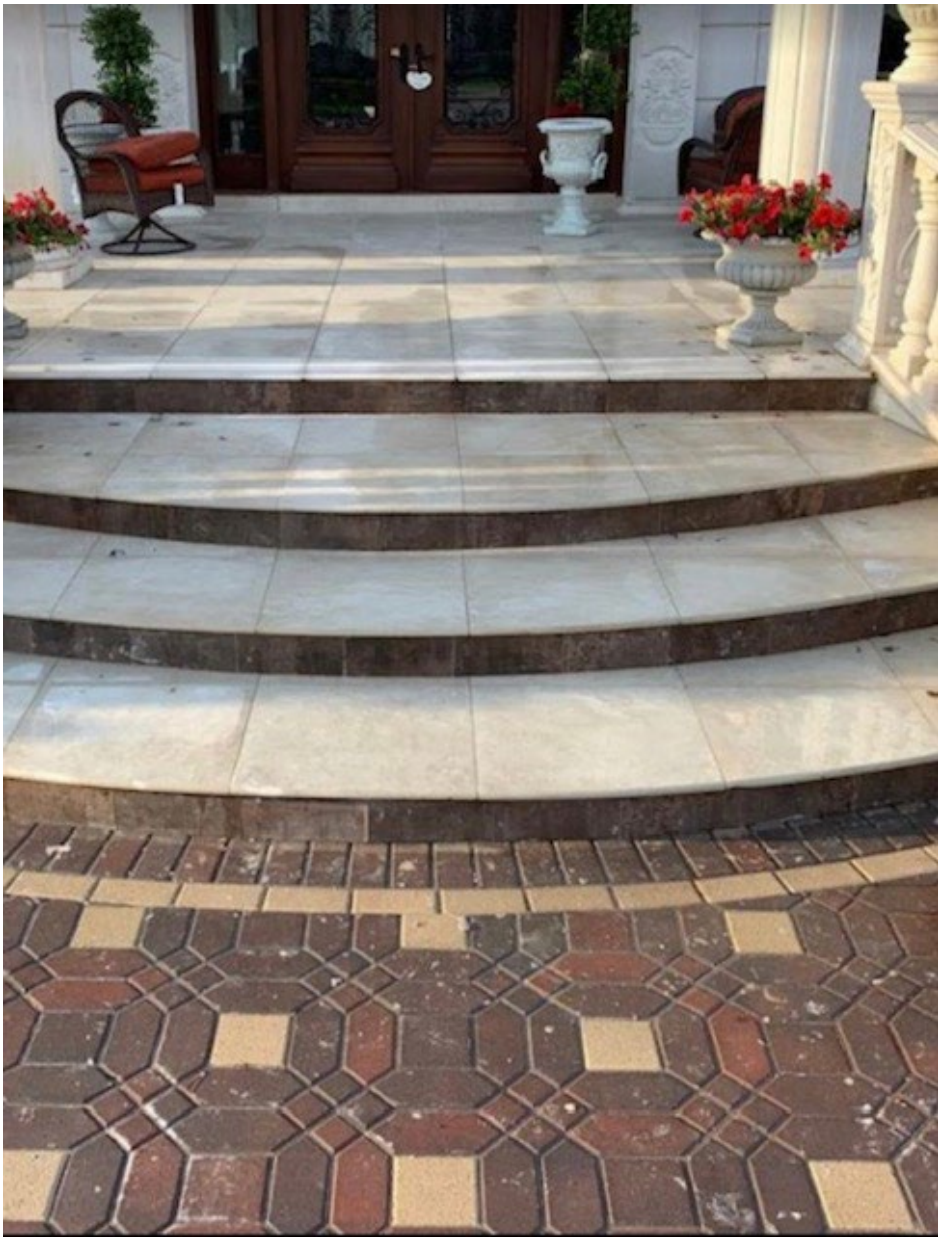

Greetings, Ms. Dye.

Thank you for your email. Here are some preliminary answers to your questions.

I reviewed the application materials for the proposal to replace the tile flooring at the front entrance, and I have the following questions:

I first need to explain that this is not just the front entrance. I need to replace the entire porch because the tiles are broken and deteriorating as a result of almost 100 years
