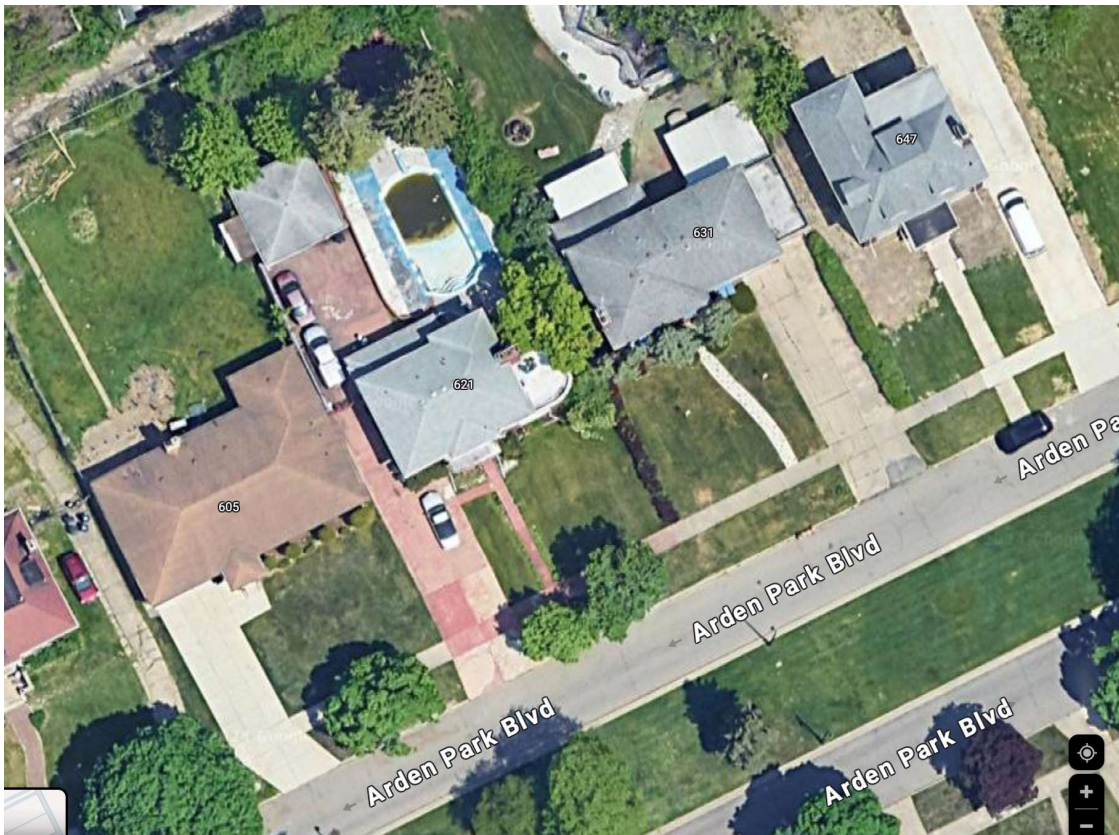

Thank you, Timothy -

The 600 block of Arden Park has several homes with double-width driveways to accommodate two cars. Though my request does not comply with a “straight, single-width driveway” being it's a curved expansion, I'd like to point out the driveways below and attached do not either.

My home was built in 1912, the model T was invented in 1909 and widely adopted from 1913-1923. The conception of my home and driveway was likely to accommodate horse and carriage, not a vehicle. During the winter season I have approximately 8 inches of paved and plowed cement on either side of my vehicle. The sod beside the driveway becomes ice and is a hazard. My request is to create a safe and functional driveway that maintains as much green space as possible while maintaining historical integrity.
