Please see below for responses and attachments. Sorry for the delay. I was trying to get specifics on that siding for you.

- **The question I have is whether you have looked anywhere under the Insulbrick on the side walls to see if the original wood siding is still present? Please let me know. Thanks!**

There are points where we can see rotted original siding as well as points to where the original siding does not exist behind the insulbrick

- **Can you please confirm the dimension of the LP siding you have selected, and if you considered the smooth finish?**

The dimensions are __. LP Lap Smart Siding is available in 5.84" and 7.84" wide, allowing for setting the overlap to the dimension of your choice. The 5.84" width, (which is the one we intend to use), can be overlapped to set the smooth face siding at 4" exposed lap which is what the current dimension is on the house. - **Can you please send me the rear wall photo of your house? It appears to have been cut-off in the application, we can only see the second floor.**
