Hi Justin,

Under the Secretary of the Interior's federal historic tax credit program the National Park Service Technical Preservation Services review historic property change and modification proposals. Similarly for the state of Michigan historic tax credit program, the Michigan State Historic Preservation Office reviews these projects. Neither the federal, nor the state programs preemptively approve particular window products for blanket applications; however, there are some local historic societies who do this for neighborhood bylaws unrelated to the tax credit programs. Though these reviewers with the federal and state tax credit programs are familiar with products such as Quaker's which are regularly found acceptable, each project is viewed individually. We at Quaker do manufacture a hung window product (H650) built to match the profiles of a typical wood double hung window over 90% of the time, along with many different accessories which replicate the brick molds commonly found on historic buildings. We also manufacture a product which replicates industrial steel sash windows (H450), which also qualifies as acceptable more than 90% of the time. The key for a manufacturer to obtain approval is to possess the ability to modify profiles of products to match profiles on specific projects. We achieve this by producing a side-by-side comparison of our proposed design adjacent to the original design. I hope this explains the process well. Please let me know what we can do to help move your project forward.
