Again, the details of the materials to be used are what is currently there. The rotten 2x4 will be replaced by new ones.

The replacement for the siding will be new T11 boards that replaced the rotted ones.

The white paint will be a White Sherwin Williams outdoor paint as the last structure was painted white.

The diagram below will take the two very large screened area and make the three equal sized ones so that the structure is smaller so that the chances of falling through are less. It's more of a safety concern to make the openings smaller.

Gutters

Again, all of these details have been provided. The are replacement gutters to be placed into the same location that they are currently. The will be new aluminum ones to replace the old ones with rusted openings which are not affective.

The will be black in color and all ornate pieces will be placed back into position as there were.


5" K style Residential gap is .27 All downspouts are commercial 3x4 gap 0.32
