IMPORTANT: Since the two-story rear wing demolition and new construction proposal was denied by the Commission, proposing the same design is not eligible for reconsideration until one full calendar year has passed from the issuance of the Notice of Denial (NOD) OR the design is updated to meet the Commissions conditions as discussed during the meeting and included in the NOD. However, we may proceed with the remaining scopes of work under this application and formally withdraw the two-story rear wing scope from consideration.

 - Visuals to show the proportions, operation, lite configuration, and dimensions of each window
- Photos of the exterior elevations of the house (we need to see the whole sides, not close up photos, please) WITH labels to coordinate with the numbered window schedule
- Interior photos of each window proposed to be replaced to show the existing conditions (please make sure the photo shows the whole window unit and has proper lighting to see the conditions) WITH labels to coordinate with the numbered window schedule
- Proposed paint color for the shutters
- Front entrance proposed railing height

Since staff does not have authority to approve the replacement of historic windows, this application will need to go in front of the Historic District Commission at an upcoming meeting. To be included in the upcoming February 11th meeting, please provide the outstanding information by end of day Friday, January 23rd.

APPLICANT RESPONSE

We respectfully request clarification regarding the Commission's expectations for an approvable roof design. Specifically, we would appreciate guidance on whether the Commission is recommending a flat roof or a pitched roof, and if pitched, what general pitch range would be considered acceptable (e.g., 4:12, 5:12, etc.). Based on the discussion at the hearing, it is unclear whether the Commission is suggesting a return to a flat roof condition or an alternative approach. Any clarification or guidance provided would be greatly appreciated as we work to align the design with their direction.
