Ru Shann Chavous -Long - Greenway Heritage Conservancy

Ms. Ru Shann Chavous - Long, was born and raised in the City of Detroit and described herself a product of the Detroit Pubic School System. She has lived in her community for nearly 60 years. She graduated from Charles E. Chadsey High School and attended local community colleges, graduating Cum laude with a BS in Business Administration from William Tyndale College. Shortly thereafter, she became employed by Ceneral Motors Fisher Body division for a short period before being hired by the State of Michigan Department of Human Services. She was employed there for 36 years.

After she retired, she became active in her community after seeing the negative impact that blight was having on the quality of life for the residents in her the once vibrant neighborhood. She joined the Midwest Civic Council of Block Club Association in 2012 to help address the blight. Becoming involved and promoting community activism was a direct result of the increase in the number of block clubs and the formation of several non-profits that she is a member of. These include but are not limited to, the Greenway Heritage Conservancy, Greenway Grocery, Westside Coalition, Pinelawn L.L.C.
